PEKING GLASS is a unique technique perfected by the Chinese in the 18th century, created by adding layers of glass around a first mouth-blown form. To create the unique layered effect, once the first piece is blown, it is dipped into boiling liquid glass several times, then carved with a stone wheel into its final shape.

Today in China, only two small factories are still producing glass with this artisan technique, making these vases and vessels unique and rare in the modern accessories world.
